



North Road Community Primary School Homework Guidelines

Rationale

We at North Road Community Primary School believe that children should be encouraged to develop their independent learning skills at home as well as at school.

Why is homework important?

- It raises your children's achievement
- It consolidates and extends the work they have done in school
- It helps to inform you about your children's school work and allows and gives you the opportunity to support this work
- It is a valuable life skill and develops good work habits for secondary school and future employment.

Guidelines

All children in North Road Community Primary School are expected to **read at home daily to an adult who must sign their reading record**. In addition work will be sent home as follows:

Foundation Stage:

- Phonic practice – sounds, actions, blending and segmenting sounds
- Letter formation.

KS1:

- Weekly spelling booklet activity/spellings
- Weekly Mathematics task to support/extend the classroom learning from that week
- Times table / related division fact practice

Years 3-

5:

- Weekly spelling booklet activities
- Weekly Mathematics task to support/extend the classroom learning from that week
- Times table / related division fact practice

Year

6:

- Weekly spelling booklet activities
- Weekly Mathematics task to support/extend the classroom learning from that week.
- Times table / related division fact practice
- SATs revision.

Each term all children are invited to take part in an Art Challenge that will be displayed in and around the local area.

Additional work might be sent home if a child is on an additional intervention or needs some short term support with a specific area of the curriculum. Teachers will contact you directly to let you know how best to support in this situation.
