Vocabulary		What should we already know?
Seaside	A place by the sea, a beach area.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Physical and Human features of a local environment Directional language; near, far, left, right. Compass directions; North, South, East, West. How to make simple fieldwork and observations of a local study. How to construct a map with symbols on a key.
Resort	A place where people go on holiday.	
Coast / Coastline	The place where the land meets the sea / ocean.	
Human	Features of the earth that have been built by humans.	
Physical	Features of the earth that are natural.	
Tourist	A person visiting a place for fun.	
Town	A built up area, larger than a village but smaller than a city.	
North, South, East, West	The 4 directions on a compass.	
Beach	A strip of land covered in sand by the edge of the sea.	What will we know at the end of this Term?
Aerial	Taking an image from above, using an aircraft.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Name and locate the four countries making up the UK and their capital cities. Recognise famous landmarks in the UK. Name the surrounding seas of the UK. Name the 5 oceans. Identify the key features of a location and say if it is a city, town or village. Ask geographical questions. Use directional language and compass points to locate a seaside town. Construct a simple map of a seaside town.
Sea	A body of salt water, smaller than an ocean and is contained by land. Where land and the ocean meet.	
Ocean	A very large body of salt water that covers most of the Earth's surface.	
Landmark	A famous feature of a place, which can be easily seen and recognised.	
Map	A representation of an area of land or sea showing physical features, cities and roads.	
Observe	To notice something.	

Key Questions

- Can you name and locate the four countries making up the UK and their capital cities?
- Can I recognise famous landmarks in the UK?
- Can you name the surrounding seas of the UK?
- Can you name and locate the 5 oceans of the world?
- Can I identify the key features of a location in order to say whether it is a city, town or village, coastal or rural area?
- Can I ask and answer geographical questions such as: What is this place like? What or who will I see in this place? What do people do in this place?
- Can I use geographical vocabulary to describe human and physical features of the seaside?
- Can I use directional language to describe the location of a seaside and the routes on a map (near, far, left, right)?
- Can I use simple compass directions (N,S,E,W)?
- Can I use a map to identify places in the UK?
