This term we are excited to officially add Roley's Childcare Club to our wrap-around provision.

As with Breakfast Club, spaces need to be booked and paid for in advance. Ad hoc spaces are available subject to availability and must be booked and paid for by the end of the school day prior to the required session. Breakfast Club costs £2:50 per child, per session and Roley's Afterschool Club cost £9 per child and runs from 3:15pm until 5:45pm. Permission for absence will only be granted in exceptional circumstances, where the reason for the request is very clear.


