Dear Parents and carers,

It has been so wonderful to welcome all the children into school and we have been so impressed with how well they have all started to settle in, begun making new friends and how they have started to learn the routines.

PE Days

PE sessions have already begun. To confirm, Pluto Class PE Days are every Wednesday and Friday. Please continue to ensure your child comes to school dressed in their PE uniform on both of these days. Wednesday sessions will be with Mrs Pearce and Friday's PE will be led by Mr Lumsden, our Sport's Coach.

Termly Learning

Along with the rest of school, we have 3 overarching themes to our termly learning. Each class then has their own questions, which we answer through our teaching and provision. This year they are as follows:

This term the children will be finding out all about themselves, what they look like, what they feel, things they like/dislike and begin to find similarities and differences with their friends. We will be exploring our senses, learning how to keep healthy and even discover what they would like to do when they grow up. We hope the children will really enjoy it.

Phonics

This week, we are starting to teach your child to read using 'phonics'. In Phonic sessions, your child will be taught how to: recognise the sounds that each individual letter makes; identify the sounds that different combinations of letters make - such as /sh/ or /oo/; and. blend these sounds together from left to right to make a word. To find out more about phonics, how we teach it and how you can support your child at home, we would like to invite you to our Phonics information session. This will be held at 1:30 – 2pm on Wednesday 11th October.

Open Classrooms

Wednesday 11th October 2- 3pm (Directly follows the Phonic Information session)

We are looking forward to welcoming you to come and share in your child's learning ahead of Parents' Evening in November. Come and spend time with your child in the classroom and outdoor learning environments. The children will be keen to show what they have been learning about, with photos and work on display.

Reading

At North Road, we encourage a love for reading. We are proud to offer a weekly visit, on a Monday afternoon, to the school library. The children will be able to explore what the library has to offer and choose a book to borrow, bring home and share. We ask that library books are returned to school on the following Friday.

From next week, we will also start to send home your child's first reading book. This is a wordless picture book, which encourages children to tell a story or talk about the pictures. Each Friday, your child will come home with a set of grapheme (letter) cards each week. These cards are for your child to use to make up 2 or 3 letter words. They can practise sounding out each card and practise blending them to make real and nonsense words. Once they are secure in reading from these cards, we will then issue a Phonics Phase 2 levelled reading book, which has simple words to begin to sound out and blend, these books will support your child to practise the sounds taught in school.

We actively encourage daily reading and books will be changed daily. Along with your child's reading book, is a yellow reading record, this is for recording when your child is heard read, either at home or at school. Please

comment and sign the record each time you hear your child read, as this will count towards our school reading awards. *(Children may have up to two reads counted in their reading totals on any one day – teachers will sign your child's Reading Record in school if they have listened to them read. This will count as one read. We ask you to listen to your child read every day. This will be the second read. If you listen to your child read multiple times during a day, this will be counted as one daily read.)*

To ensure that the reading books, library books, letters and belongings are kept as they should, please can we ask that water bottles are not carried inside book bags, thank you.

Pick Ups

Thank you so much to all the parents who notify us of any changes to who is regularly picking up their child. Please can we also ask that every family checks their Arbor account and ensure all adults picking up have been added and /or updated as having consent to collect their child.

Pluto Class End of Term Learning Celebration

On Friday 20th October, we would like to invite the children to come dressed up in something that tells us about them. This could be: a football kit for their favourite team; Clothing or uniform from a club/activity ie ballet, gymnastics or football club; Something showing us what they would like to be when they grow up or anything else that is special or significant to them. We can't wait to see what everyone is wearing.
