The Anglo Saxons come to settle and farm. The Anglo Saxons built their houses from wood. They lived in small, wooden houses made of wattle and daub. The Anglo Saxons ate fruit and vegetables and kept animals for meat, milk, cheese, and eggs. They had plenty of fish as they mostly lived near the sea. The differences between the life of Anglo Saxon men and Anglo Saxon women. Anglo Saxons made their clothes from wool, linen, and animal skins. The Vikings invaded Britain during the time of the Anglo Saxons. 	
Settler	People who migrate to a new place. When people start a community in the new place, this is known as a settlement		
Thane	After Kings, Thanes were the most powerful Anglo Saxons. They helped the king rule the land and were in charge of a village.
